The first half of the month had unseasonably warm temperatures, including a record high of 58 degrees reported for January 2nd. The second half of January had below zero temperatures with a six-inch snow event between 0700 Jan 19 and 0700 Jan 20. The month wound up 1.7 degrees above the average temperature-wise. As far as precipitation, January was 0.16" above the average, as well as 4.7" above the average for the snowfall total.
