Discussion:

June might look normal by the numbers but it was characterized by several extreme precipitation and temperature events. Above average temperatures at the beginning of the month resulted in severe weather in the form of wind damage and a 4.23 inch deluge on the 3rd and 4th of the month. These two days were responsible for over 80% of the rainfall for the month. This heavy rainfall event was accompanied by six days of below 80 degree temperatures.

The month turned warm and dry following the cool spell. A tenth of an inch of precipitation or more was recorded only three times the rest of the month. A streak of five days of above 90 degree heat was recorded on the 21st through 25th, bringing June to near normal temperature and precipitation monthly averages.

One other severe weather event occurred on June 10th to areas just northwest of DeKalb in the form of wind damage. The heavy rains early in the month will have an effect on the yields come harvest time this fall due to ponding in fields.
