Discussion

Above average temperatures and well below average precipitation were the highlights in September. The 66.9°F average temperature this month was 2.7°F above the monthly average of 64.2°F, which makes September 2002 the 15th warmest on record dating back to 1896. September was also another dry month as only 1.62 inches was recorded. This amount was over 2 inches below the average of 3.68 inches and the 19th driest September on record. All of the precipitation this month was associated with two storm systems, the first coming through the area on September 2nd and 3rd, when 0.38 inches was measured. The other precipitation event was on the 17th - 22nd when a total of 1.2 inches fell across the area. The more than 2 inch deficit in precipitation this month once again drops us below the annual average by 1.63

If you thought the last 4 months have been warm in Dekalb, you are right. Dekalb has averaged 2.54°F above normal since June, making this the 3rd warmest June-September period on record in Dekalb.
