## Discussion

July 2006 was a month of slightly above average temperatures and missed opportunities for rain. The average high temperature for the month was only $0.3^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ above the 30 -year average, where as the average low temperature was $2.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ above the 30 -year average. This caused the average temperature for the month of July to be $1.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ above the 30 -year average. What many people will remember, however, is the heat. This included 6 days over $90^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, with the high for the month $95^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ which occurred on the $18^{\text {th }}$. This was tempered by two cool spells when the high temperatures drop to the middle 70s.

Despite the above average temperatures, we were lacking on rain fall for the month. This was not due to lack of trying on Mother Nature's part. There were numerous occasions where heavy rainfall fell across northern Illinois, but it did not make it to DeKalb. For example on the $18^{\text {th }}$, DeKalb had 0.01 " of rain, whereas Rockford had 1.48 " despite Rockford only being 25 miles away from DeKalb. The rain total for the month totaled 2.41 " which is 1.85 " below the 30 -year average of 4.26 inches.
