## Discussion


April 2007 was a month that was slightly below average for temperatures and average for precipitation. In fact, the total precipitation for April 2007 of 3.52", was exactly the 30-year average for the month. For the year, DeKalb is above average for liquid precipitation with a recorded 9.7" since January 1<sup>st</sup>. The 30-year average for precipitation is 8.43". April 2007 was a cool month, with the average high, low, and mean monthly temperatures all below the 30-year averages, respectively. The month ranked as the 12<sup>th</sup> coldest on record for DeKalb, with an average temperature of 45.9°F. The coldest April was in 1975 with an average temperature of 43.8°F. The majority of the cold air was in the first half of the month, when there were three days where the high was at or below the average low. However, by the end of the month, the temperatures warmed up, with two of the last eight days over 80°F.

As with most spring months in the Midwest, April 2007 in DeKalb had large swings in the weather. One example was a high temperature of 68°F on April 4<sup>th</sup> that was followed by a trace of snow the next day.
