## Discussion

The average low, the average high, and the average temperatures were all warmer than the $1971-2000$ average by $3.6^{\circ} \mathrm{F}, 1.5^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, and $2.5^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, respectively, for the month of September 2007. The average high temperature was the $3^{\text {rd }}$ warmest September on record while the average temperature, $66.6^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, was the $6^{\text {th }}$ warmest average temperature. September's warmest temperature was $90^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, occurring twice on the $5^{\text {th }}$ and again on the $25^{\text {th }}$. The coolest temperature was $35^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, occurring on both the $15^{\text {th }}$ and the $16^{\text {th }}$.

There was only 0.44 " of rain that fell in September 2007, 3.03 " below the average rainfall for this month. This amount is also extremely low when comparing the 0.44 " in September to August 2007’s 12.02" of rainfall. This is the $2^{\text {nd }}$ driest September on record, behind only September 1979 which had only 0.04 " of rain. Despite this extremely dry September, we are still 7.02" above average for liquid equivalent for the year. The January-September 2007 rainfall ranks as the $5^{\text {th }}$ wettest on record.
