## Discussion

The August 2008 average high temperature was $80.2^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, which is slightly lower than the average high of $82^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. The average August 2008 low temp was $58.0^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, which is also cooler than the normal average low of $60.7^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. Overall, the month was cooler than normal with an average August temperature $2.3^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ below average. Surprisingly, there were no days during the month where the temperature was above $90^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.

With 1.95 inches of total precipitation in August 2008 it was the $9^{\text {th }}$ driest August on record. More than half of the rainfall came on one day, August $5^{\text {th }}$, when we received 1.05 inches. Also during the month there was a span of 10 days without rain, from August $10^{\text {th }}$ to the $19^{\text {th }}$.
