Discussion

December 2008 experienced temperatures much colder than normal. The average December 2008 high was about 4°F cooler than the 1971-2000 average high, and the average low was almost 10°F cooler than the 30-year average. December 2008 was the 5th coolest December on record. There were eight days during the month when the temperature dropped below 0°F.

During the month, there were 5.85" of liquid-equivalent precipitation; that ranks 1st among all Decembers on record. The precipitation was distributed evenly throughout the entire month. There were 28" of snow in December of 2008; that ranks 3rd all time among all Decembers on record. There were four days throughout the month where there were 4"+ of snow accumulation, and it snowed an amazing 19 out of the 31 days of the month. Year-to-date precipitation has reached 46.67 inches; that is almost 10" greater than the climate normal.
