## Discussion

December 2008 experienced temperatures much colder than normal. The average December 2008 high was about $4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ cooler than the 1971-2000 average high, and the average low was almost $10^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ cooler than the 30 -year average. December 2008 was the $5^{\text {th }}$ coolest December on record. There were eight days during the month when the temperature dropped below $0^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.

During the month, there were 5.85 "of liquid-equivalent precipitation; that ranks $1^{\text {st }}$ among all Decembers on record. The precipitation was distributed evenly throughout the entire month. There were 28 " of snow in December of 2008; that ranks $3^{\text {rd }}$ all time among all Decembers on record. There were four days throughout the month where there were 4 " + of snow accumulation, and it snowed an amazing 19 out of the 31 days of the month. Year-to-date precipitation has reached 46.67 inches; that is almost 10 " greater than the climate normal.
