Discussion

Overall, February 2008 was a very cold and wet. The average high was the 4th coldest on record at 7.6°F below the 1971-2000 average high. The February average high was so cool that it was a mere 0.3°F warmer than the 1971-2000 average temperature for February. The average temperature for February 2008 was the 6th coldest on record, 7.2°F cooler than the 1971-2000 average temperature. The average low for February 2008 was the 8th coldest and below the 1971-2000 average low by 6.3°F.

The 3.81 inches of liquid equivalent precipitation that fell in February 2008 placed as the 2nd most on record. The amount of liquid precipitation that occurred more than doubled, and came close to tripling, the 1971-2000 average liquid precipitation for February. A total of 22.7 inches of snow fell in February 2008 making this February the 2nd snowiest on record. The seasonal snow to date for 2007-08 also ranks as the 2nd snowiest on record for the seasonal snowfall to date (ending in February). The snowiest season on record is 1978-79 when 80.3 inches of snow fell.
