## Discussion

The temperatures for September 2009 were near average. The average high was slightly below normal, the average low was slightly above normal and the overall average temperature was almost exactly the same as the 30 -year average; $64.1^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ is the 30 -year average temperature whereas the average temperature for September 2009 was $64.0^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. There were five days during the month when the low temperature fell below 50 degrees, and only one day when the high temperature failed to reach 60 degrees.

In September of 2009 DeKalb received 1.18 inches of rain, which is well below the 30-year average for September ( 3.47 inches). September 2009 was also a very dry month compared to previous months this year although the year to date average precipitation for DeKalb is still 6 inches above the historic average. September 2009 was the sixth driest September on record
