Discussion

April 2009 exhibited cooler than normal temperatures. Each of the monthly average temperatures (i.e., HI, LOWand TEMP) was approximately two degrees cooler than those recorded between 1971 and 2000. April 2009 ranks 10th among similar months historically with respect to its average low (35.5 °F). Temperatures exceeded 80 degrees for only one day while temperatures dropped into the 20s five days this month. In April 2009 there was a total of 4.35" of liquid equivalent precipitation; this is 0.83" greater than the historic average for this month. There was also 1.5" of snowfall recorded this month, all of which occurred on a single day, the 6th. The 1.5" of snowfall is 0.4" more than average for this month and ranks 9th among similar months on record. The additional 1.5" of snow in April of 2009 brings the seasonal snowfall total to 51.16" which is 16.16" greater than the seasonal average.
