Discussion


Temperatures for June 2009 were below normal in that the average monthly temperatures were lower than the 30-year averages for similar months on record. June 2009 ranks fourth relative to the lowest average high temperatures on record for similar months. So while most days recorded lower than average temperatures, there was a period near the end of the month when temperatures exceeded 90 degrees or higher. These higher temperatures occurred five times within a six-day span from June 23rd to June 28th. There were also five days during the month when the high temperature did not reach 70 degrees and five days when the low temperature dropped below 50 degrees; these events occurred during the beginning of the month.

The total precipitation recorded for June 2009, 6.16 inches, ranks ninth among similar months on record. Precipitation was fairly evenly distributed throughout the month, save for June 8th when a recorded 2.20 inches of rain fell, accounting for nearly a third of the month's total precipitation. The cumulative total of precipitation recorded at the DeKalb station this year is 25.98 inches, which surpasses the year-to-date average by 8.36 inches. June 2009 now represents the fifth straight month that the recorded precipitation exceeded the average monthly precipitation.
