#### Abstract

Discussion October's mean temperature of $59.7^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ was six degrees cooler than the historical normal. October started out with high temperatures close to the daily averages, ranging from lower 70s to upper 60s. Most of October included high temperatures that were within the middle to upper 50's, with the highest temperature recorded on October $25^{\text {th }}$ at $77^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. On the $25^{\text {th }}$ there was a record highest low at $60^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, which ranks first for the Dekalb co-op station (1966-2012). The lowest temperature for October was recorded on the $6^{\text {th }}$ at $27^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. Comparing October historical rankings for mean temperature (1966-2012), 2012 ranked as the sixth coldest with a mean temperature at $49.1^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. The coldest October was 1987 , with a mean temperature of $44.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. Liquid Equivalent precipitation total for the month of October was 3.17 in . In comparison to the historical records extending to 1966 , October's total ranks $15^{\text {th }}$ wettest month; the driest October was in 2005 at 0.53 in .
