Discussion

February's mean temperature of 21.9°F was four degrees cooler than the historical normal. February started out with high temperatures below the daily averages, ranging from lower teens to upper 40s. Most of February included high temperatures that were within the middle to upper 20's, with the highest temperature recorded on February 19th at 48°F. The lowest temperature for February was recorded on the 2nd at -4°F. Comparing February historical rankings for mean temperature (1966-2013), 2013 ranked as the thirteenth coldest with a mean temperature at 21.9°F. The coldest February was 2007, with a mean temperature of 13.7°F. Liquid Equivalent precipitation total for the month of February was 2.66 in. In comparison to the historical records extending to 1966, February's total ranks 5th wettest month; the wettest February was in 1997 at 4.90in. Total snowfall for February was 16.7in. Comparing February historical rankings for snowfall with records extending from 1966; February ranks 6th greatest total snowfall for the month. The highest snowfall for February was recorded in 1994 with a snowfall total of 26.4in
