Discussion

February's average temperature of 27.7°F was 2.7 degrees above the historical average temperature. This month's average temperature was the 14th warmest on record for DeKalb. The average high of 34.9 degrees was 1.9 degrees above the historical average. The average low of 20.5 degrees was 3.5 degrees above the historical average. There were only nine days where the daily low temperature fell below the historical average. There were two days that broke records for high temperatures, February 20th and 29th.


February had 0.71 inches of liquid precipitation, which is just under half of the February average. February 2016 was the 9th driest February on record for DeKalb. The month's snow total was 5.0 inches, which is under 2.3 inches under the average for February. Seventy-six percent of the total snowfall fell on February 15th. The 2015-16 seasonal snow to date total now stands at 21.4 inches, which is almost six inches under the seasonal snow to date average.
