Discussion
September had an average temperature of $68.2^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, which is just over four degrees above the historical average of $64.1{ }^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. The average high temperature of $78.2^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ was 2.9 degrees above the historical average high temperature of $75.3^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. The average low temperature of $58.2{ }^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ was 5.4 degrees above the historical average low temperature of $52.8^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$. September had 20 days with average or above average highs and 22 days with above average lows. September's highest temperatures were recorded in the middle of the month with the highest temperature recorded on the $7^{\mathrm{th}}$ at $91^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.

September's precipitation total for 2016 was 2.17 in., which is almost an inch below the average of 3.16 in . This brings the year to date liquid equivalent total to 32.02 in., which is 2.94 in. above the liquid equivalent year to date average. Most of the precipitation fell towards the second half of the month with just $29 \%$ of the precipitation falling from September $1^{\text {st }}$ to the $15^{\text {th }}$ and $71 \%$ of the precipitation falling from September $16^{\text {th }}$ to the $30^{\text {th }}$.
