Discussion

April's average temperature was 51.3 degrees, which is warmer than the historical average temperature of 48.7 degrees. April's average high of 61.6 degrees was warmer than the historical average, with the average low temperature being 3.2 degrees warmer than the historical average. April had 21 days with at or above average highs and 20 days with at or above average lows. April had its highest temperature on the 16th at 79 degrees; this was 18 degrees above the average for the day. April did not see any record-breaking temperatures.

The April 2017 precipitation total was 5.19 in., which was 1.93 in. above the 30-year average. The 2017 liquid-equivalent year to date now is 12.58 in, which is 4.04 inches above average. Forty-nine percent of the precipitation fell within the first half of the month. The highest amount of precipitation fell on the 30th, with 1.64 inches on that day. There was no snowfall for April, which is 0.8 in. below average.


