Discussion

November's average temperature was 35.8 °F, which is 2.7 degrees cooler than the historical average temperature. November's average high of 44.1 F was 2.8 degrees cooler than the historical average high, with the average minimum temperature of 35.8F being cooler than the historical average by 2.7 degrees. November had 10 days with above average highs and 9 days with above average lows. November had its highest temperature on the 29th at 57 degrees. This was 16 degrees above the average for the day. Also, November had 25 days where the low temperatures were at or below freezing. November 11th tied the record Low for the day of 13 °F.

November's precipitation total for 2017 was 1.6 in., which was 1.08 in. below the average. The 2017 liquid-equivalent year to date now is 40.85 in. The total for 2017 is 5.34 inches above the year to date average of 35.51 in. Eighty-four percent of the precipitation fell within the first half of the month. The largest daily precipitation amount occurred on November 13th with 0.24 inches. This year, November received a trace of snowfall.
