## MONTHLY CLIMATE SUMMARY, JUNE 2019 <br> NIU WEATHER SERVICE: DE KALB, IL.



## Discussion

As for temperature, June of 2019 did not see any record-breaking numbers, although it was a rather cool month. The June average temperature of $67.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ was $1.8^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ below the historical average. The average high temperature was $2.8^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ below the historical high average temperature of 80.3 degrees. The average low temperature was $0.6^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ below the historical low average of 59 degrees. June had 19 days with at or below average highs and 19 days with at or below average lows.

June 2019 was the $9^{\text {th }}$ driest June we've had since records began in 1966 with a total of 2.69 inches of precipitation, quite a contrast from the wet start to the year we had. Total precipitation for the month was 2.69 inches, which is 1.49 inches below the historical average of 4.18 inches for June. Year to date precipitation stands at 21.42 inches, which is 4.15 inches above average. Precipitation was relatively evenly distributed as forty one percent of precipitation fell in the first half of the month. The highest amount of precipitation fell on the $16^{\text {th }}$, with 0.86 inches of precipitation on that day. There was no snowfall in June, which matched the average.

There were 38 heating degree days making the total since last July 7248 days, 317.5 HDDs more than at this point last year. There were 588 growing degree days for the month, making the yearly total 889.5 . We had 126 cooling degree days, making the yearly total 138.5 .
